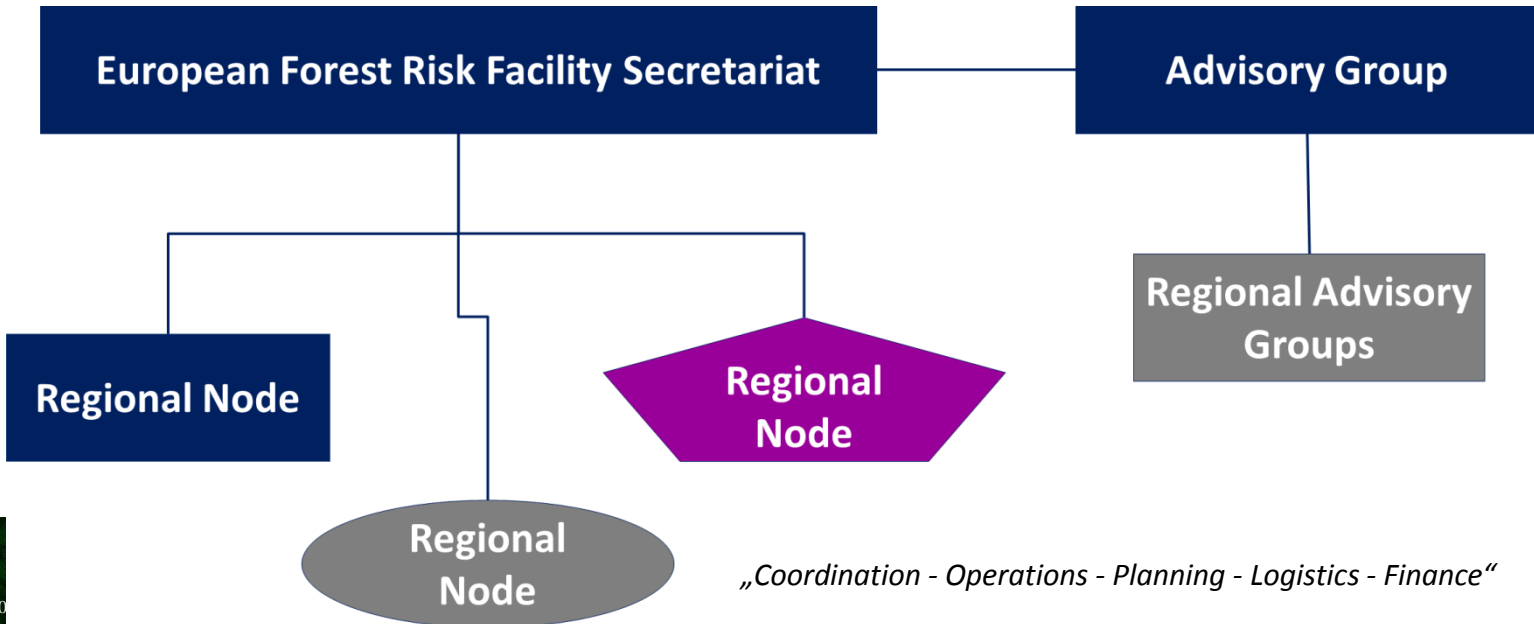


Structure and set-up – the theory



Secretariat: facilitates, assists, coordinates....

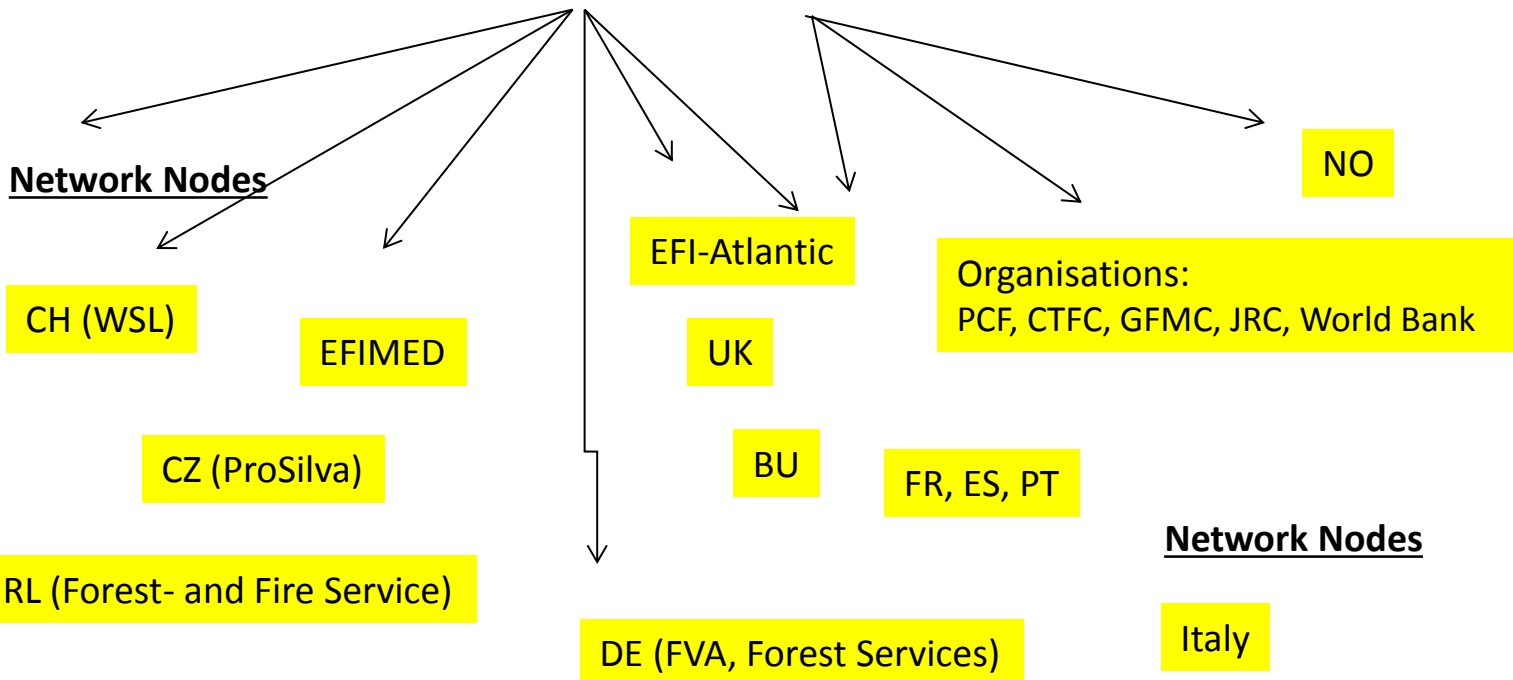
Networks: provide nodes, expertise, knowledge, experts

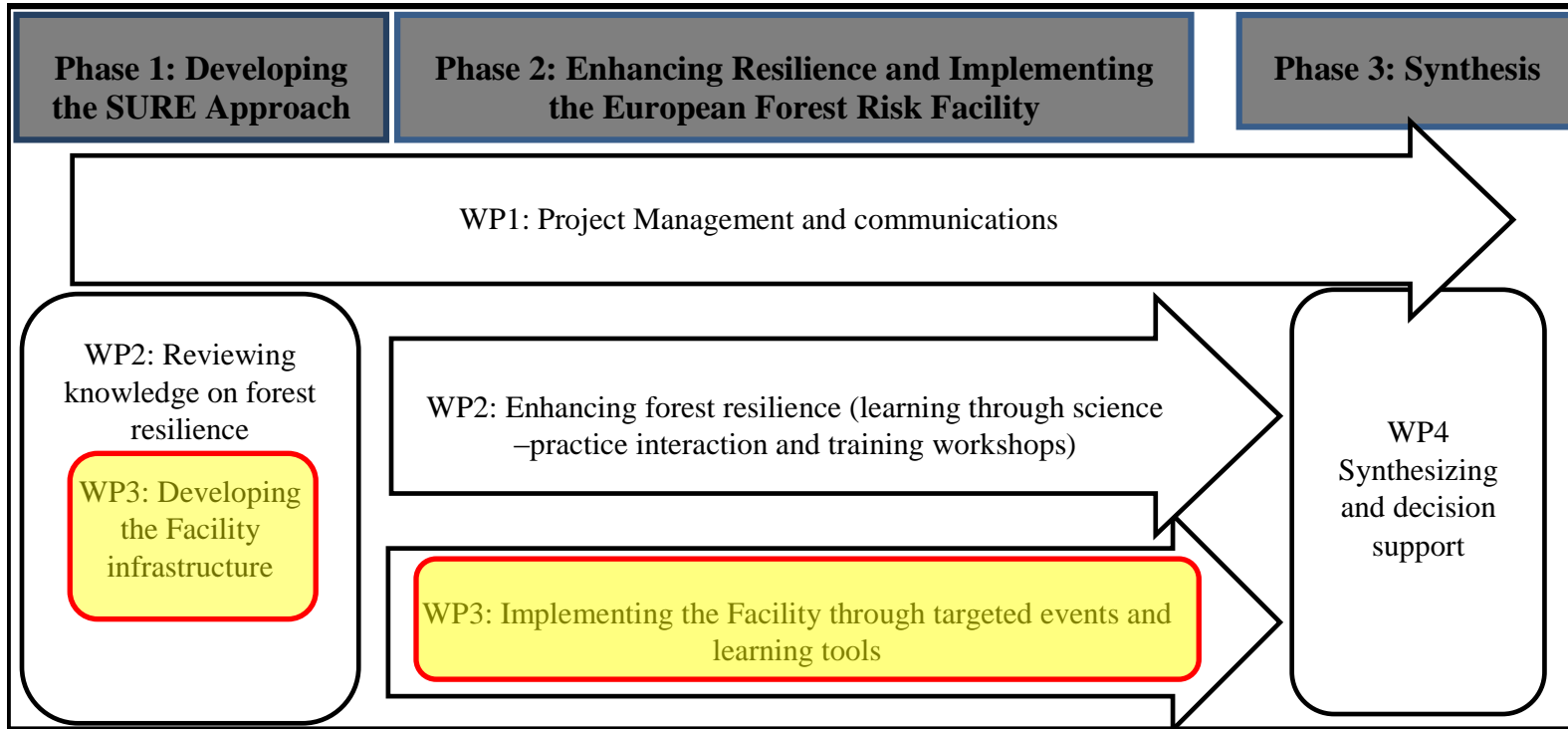


Figure 1: Work packages and Work Flow in SURE
